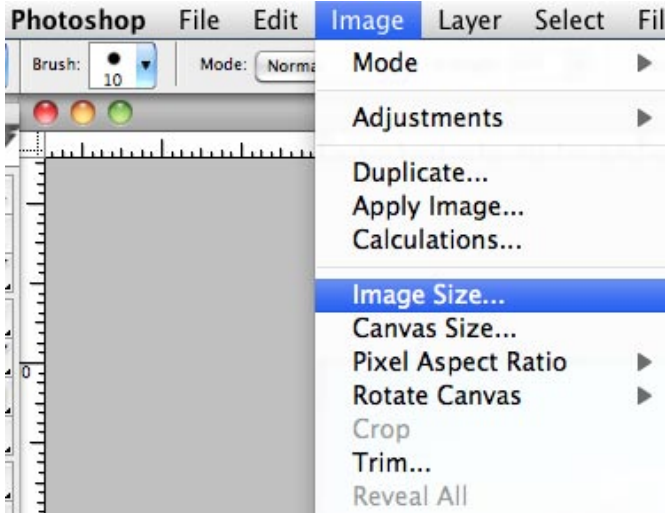
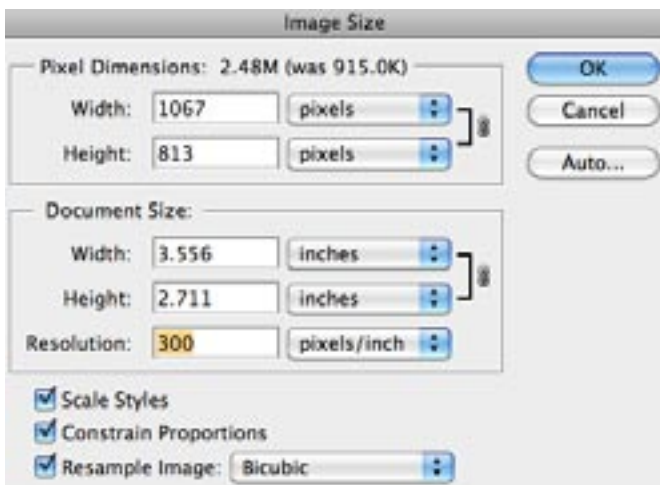


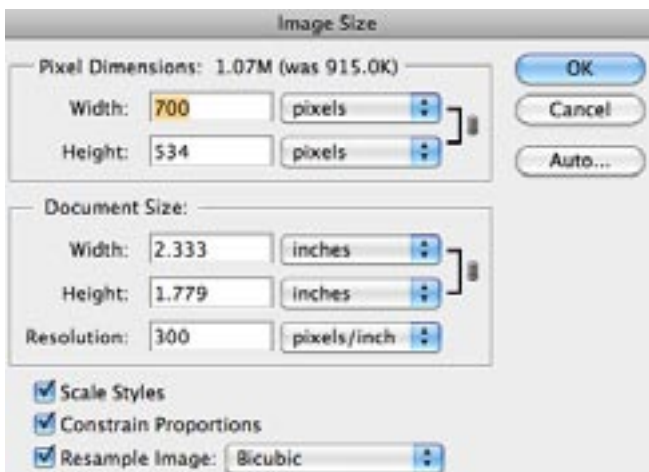

Instructions for PSNM National Show Entries

The examples shown here may also be relevant to entering other shows, but the specific dpi, pixel dimensions and file name protocol may differ. Please be sure to read the show prospectus carefully.

In Photoshop

If using any other image editing software, steps should be similar to those shown here.

(Example A) Once image is cropped properly, go to Image, scroll down to Image Size to open dialog box.

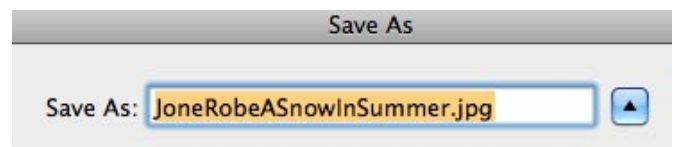
(Example B) Be sure resolution is 300. Pixel dimensions will automatically change based on your original resolution.

(Example C) If longest dimension of image is more than 700 pixels, change it to 700. Shorter dimension will adjust proportionally.

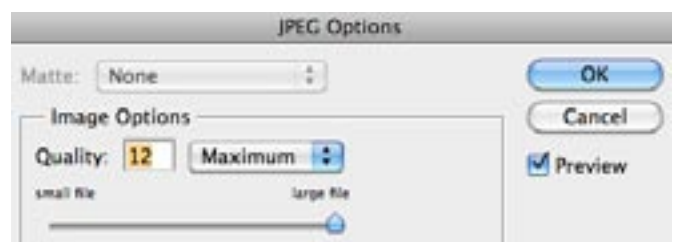
(Example D) Go to Save As, located in the drop down menu under File. Name the file, paying careful attention to the file naming protocol. For example: a photo might come from your camera as IMG - 4924.JPG but for the National Show, name it as follows: 1st 4 letters of Last Name, 1st 4 letters of First Name, Entry Letter (corresponding to entry form), Painting Title (use up to maximum your computer allows for file names).

Example: Artist's Name: Robert Jones; Entry A; Title: Snow in Summer will be named: JoneRobeASnowInSummer.jpg

(Example E) After clicking SAVE button in step described in Example D, the JPEG Options Dialog Box will open. Set Quality to 12 with Maximum shown to right. Click OK button.
