Marie Meyer, author of the new book "Multi-Brand Color Chart of Pastels" published by Huechroval Corporation, is this month's meeting speaker. Her presentation will explore "Hue, Chroma and Value in Pastels".

Gallery Pages on PSNM Website

Time to Renew or Apply!

Cost of a web page is \$75 per year, payable annually at the time PSNM membership is renewed. Fee covers the setup of a new page, including a brief resume, artist's statement, and one to four correctly formatted digital images of your work. It must also include an email address or other contact information.

The gallery is updated three times a year, February, June, and October, when you provide new images in January, May and September. There is no additional cost for this service. If you wish to update text during the year, there will be an additional charge of \$10 to scan your typewritten text (handwritten text will not scan), but no charge for text submitted digitally via email.
